

Special Issue of the Journal of Symbolic Computation



All the participants of the MEGA 2011 conference are invited to submit a paper for a Special Issue of the Journal of Symbolic Computation.

This invitation is also extended to any researcher interested in the topics of the MEGA conference.

The guiding principles for the publication procedure will be as follows:

Research papers (not necessarily bound to a lecture at the conference) on a topic associated with MEGA are welcome.

- The introduction of the paper must explicitly address the following questions in succinct and informal manner:
- 1. What is the problem?
- 2. Why is the problem important?
- 3. What has been done so far on the problem?
- 4. What is the main contribution of the paper on the problem?
- 5. Is the contribution original? Explain why.
- 6. Is the contribution non-trivial? Explain why.
- All the main definitions, theorems and algorithms must be illustrated by simple but meaningful examples.

All the papers will be refereed according to the JSC standards.
